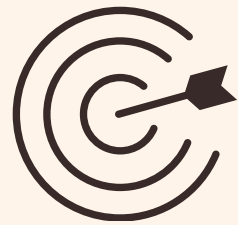


7 steps to a SUSTAINABILITY PLAN for social enterprises

Identify the specific social and environmental objectives your enterprise aims to achieve.



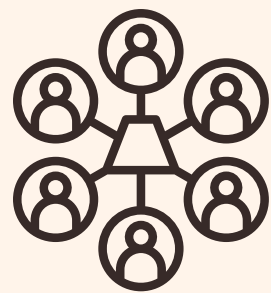
2. ASSESS THE CURRENT SITUATION

Formulate concrete measures and initiatives that contribute to achieving the set sustainability goals.



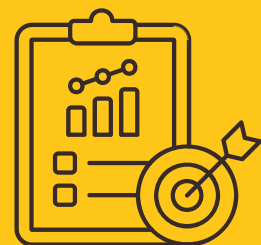
5. SET MEASURABLE GOALS AND KPI'S
